May 11	Last day for policy committees to hear and report to the floor non-fiscal bills
May 25	Last day for policy committees to meet prior to June 11
May 28	Memorial Day
June 1	Last day for fiscal committees to hear and report bills to the floor. Last day for fiscal committees to meet prior to June 11.
June 4- June 8	Floor session only. No committee may meet for any purpose
June 8	Last day to pass bills out of the house of origin
June 11	Committee meetings may resume
June 15	Budget Bill must be passed by midnight
July 4	Independence Day
July 13	Last day for policy committees to hear and report bills
July 20	Summer Recess begins on adjournment, provided Budget Bill has been passed.
Aug 20	Legislature reconvenes from Summer Recess
Aug 31	Last day for fiscal committees to meet and report bills to the Floor.
Sept 3	Labor Day Observed
Sept 3- Sept 14	Floor session only. No committee may meet for any purpose.
Sept 7	Last day to amend bills on the floor.
Sept 14	Last day for any bills to be passed. Interim Recess begins upon adjournment.
Oct 8	Columbus Day Observed
Oct 14	Last day for Governor to sign or veto bills passed by the Legislature on or before Sept. 14 and in the Governor's possession after Sept 14.
